- Emergency Repairs: If needed, you can make temporary repairs using roof mastic and fiberglass fabric. However, contact WeatherWeld™ for a permanent solution to maintain your warranty.

Alterations

Control Roof Access

Untrained individuals can accidentally damage your roof. Keep a log of all visitors who access the roof and limit entry to authorized personnel. This is not required but recommended.

Walkways

If you have equipment that needs regular servicing in the future, consider installing walkways. This protects the membrane from damage caused by foot traffic and extends the life of your roof.

8. Roof Cleaning

Keeping your roof clean is recommended. Regularly remove dirt, leaves, and debris to prevent clogged drains, ponding water, and premature membrane wear. Clean roofs also allow you to feel confident in your investment.

9. Reflective Coatings - Optional

Reflective coatings are optional and not required to maintain your 40-year NDL Leak-Free Warranty. These coatings are ancillary to the core performance of the WeatherWeld™ system. Here's what you should know about reflective coatings:

- California Requirement: Reflective coatings are required in California to meet initial Title 24 guidelines, but they are not a necessity outside of these regulations.
- **Longevity and Maintenance**: You are not required to recoat the roof to maintain your warranty. However, if you prefer, you can choose to recoat your roof after 12 years, but this is entirely optional.
- **Ponded Water Areas**: Reflective coatings may peel in areas where water ponds. Rest assured, the WeatherWeld™ system beneath the coating is 1/4 inch thick and is designed to withstand minor ponding water without any compromise to its waterproof integrity. You may recoat these areas as needed, but it is not required to maintain your warranty.
